During the spring tide the land will be partially flooded and thus become a peninsula. This is the ideal location to see the famous salt meadow sheep.

The campsite offers you 466 tent sites of 80 to 100m<sup>2</sup> each in an area over 11 hectares within wavy dunes with direct access to the beach. These tent sites aren't defined by hedges so the natural image will be conserved.

The campsite de la Vanlée was opened for the 31 Rallye de la fédération international de camping caravanning in 1970. It is the duty of the town councils of Briqueville sur mer and Bréhal, which are situated in the vicinity of the bay of St. Michael's Mount, to maintain the establishment to attract a huge crowd of international campers.
